The realization of **"Tulong Panghanapbuhay sa Ating Disadvantaged/Displaced Workers"** (TUPAD) Program made a mark not only to the Coop NATCCO

Party-list but to those who have been given an opportunity to earn despite losing their jobs because of the Covid-19 Pandemic.

The TUPAD implemented by COOP-NATCCO Party-List, Davao del Norte Chapter, in partnership with the Department of Labor and Employment (DOLE) is a form of assistance that provides emergency employment for the disadvantaged/displaced workers in our community. The program runs for a maximum period of 10 Days with each Program-Beneficiary paid at Php 396.00 per Day, the approved minimum daily wage in Region XI.

Last November 4, 2021, Coop NATCCO Party-List through the initiative of Davao del Norte and Region XI Chapters Director ANTONIO President, C. ARAÑAS, MPA, proceeded with the promised cash distribution at Kapalong Cooperative (Municipality of Kapalong, Davao del Norte). Some twenty-eight (28) identified beneficiaries from the Municipality of Kapalong, Davao del Norte, went to Kapalong Cooperative to receive the cash provision. The event was attended by Mr. EXPEDITO L. BAYUDAN, Campaign Coordinator of COOP NATCCO; Ms. MA. TERESA B. SERMON, BOD Secretary of Kapalong Cooperative; and Mr. DANIEL C.

PACHECO, General Manager of Kapalong Cooperative.

60 identified displaced workers from BARANGAY CUAMBOGAN, TAGUM CITY. DAVAO DEL NORTE also received the same benefit at Barangay Hall in Cuambogan under the supervision of Mr. ROBERTO ISAAL, Barangay Captain of Barangay Cuambogan; and Ms. ARMING CAACBAY, Barangay Education & Employment Desk Officer; Mr EXPEDITO L. BAYUDAN, Campaign Coordinator of COOP NATCCO; In addition to the 60 beneficiaries of Barangay Cuambogan in Tagum City (60) identified are another sixty beneficiaries from BARANGAY EAST, TAGUM MAGUGPO CITY, DAVAO DEL NORTE, attended by Mr. ROGELIO M. VERALLO, Barangay Kagawad: and Mr. EXPEDITO L. BAYUDAN, Campaign Coordinator of COOP NATCCO.

COOP NATCCO PARTY-LIST: PPES FOR DRMC AND LGU TAGUM

As the battle against Covid-19 continues. Coop NATCCO Party-(CNPL) List also unceasingly does its duty of extending its hand to the community in the form of Personal Protective Equipment (PPEs) specifically Coveralls/Scrub Suits. A total of 110 pieces of PPEs was handed over Davao Regional to Medical Center (DRMC) and the Local Government of Tagum last November 3, 2021.

The simple vet meaninaful turn-over ceremonies took place at DRMC, Tagum City, Davao del Norte, and the City Hall of Tagum, respectively. CNPL's primary purpose in donating the PPEs is to make sure that the "frontliners". such as Doctors and Nurses who are risking their lives to protect the people are themselves protected, that these knowing workers come home to their own families. The use of PPEs could help curb the damaging effects that Covid-19 might bring to the medical workers' households.



LGU Tagum continues to roll out vaccinations to the members of the community through opening additional vaccination sites to make vaccines more accessible to the community. CNPL sees a way to extend help to those who are still combatting the virus in hospitals through its provision of said PPEs so the medical workers will be able to protect themselves while treating Covid-19 patients.



CNPL HANDS OVER PPES TO DAVAO DEL NORTE PROVINCE

Coop NATCCO Party-List led by its diligent Davao del Norte and Region XI Chapters President, Director ANTONIO C.
